Much of the discussion centered on what is known about the Academy rules concerning FPV (First Person View) flying at AMA chartered club flying sites and what has not been ruled upon yet by the AMA and the FAA. The consensus of about twenty minutes of this discussion was that the whole issue will have to be worked out in a special board meeting before the end of the year with new safety/operational rules to be ready for the 2016 flying season.

Old Business: Questions were raised about any changes with the website and the club picnic scheduled for 9/20. The website issue had not been settled and scheduling of the CAP visit by about 35-40 cadets and parents led into the decision to not hold the picnic but to shift resources to the Christmas Social on December 3rd.

New Business: Andre presented Mike Shaw with his solo wings for successfully and safely piloting a model airplane from take-off to landing. Thunderous applause was heard.


D. Lampron reminded everyone of the upcoming Fly-In at the Wintonbury Flying Club in Wintonbury, CT on the 4th & 5th.
