## Hampshire County Radio Controllers, Inc. • Business Meeting, AUGUST 6, 2015

### MINUTES:

The meeting was brought to order at 7 p.m. by Pres. Mark who quickly asked for the roll to be called. The secretary got a response from 22 members attending and no guests were reported present.

Mark asked for a motion to waive the reading of the minutes. The motion was made, seconded and passed. (M/S/P)

Next he asked the treasurer to give his monthly financial report with items of expense and income detailed and explained. As noted, the report is always available to any member at any time. M/S/P

**Committee Reports** — Dave Lavigne thanked those who worked with him representing HCRC at the Great New England Air Show (Westover ARB). He, along with Tracy Page, Ed Kopec and Bill Jaciow, worked both days at the event.

**Old Business** — Leo gave special thanks to the secretary for appearing at the fund raising banquet for the newly approved military and transportation museum to be built at Barnes Airport. A display of HCRC information and his replica of a “Doolittle Raider” B-25 occupied center stage during the event held at the East Mountain Country Club.

**New Business** — Dave Lampron asked for help with a work party to do the final field repairs to the lower end of the flight line. He asked for 4 to 5 members to join him on next Monday evening at 5 p.m. Several members volunteered including Dean, Leo, Eddie, Dave W., and Gordie. A message over the internet will be sent to all members (using email) requesting non-flying during that work period. Mark had a few additional comments about not parking on the flying field, a meeting on Thurs. night for the upcoming Scale Fly-In (at the field) and a board meeting on Wed. at 7p.m. also at the field. He also discussed the dues increase for members of the AMA with an incentive to pay early for one or two years at the same present rate. Mark thanked the secretary for the rebuild of the five white safety barriers along with the new blocks set into the ground. Dave W. donated some of the new blocks, he said. Mark also talked about our members respecting the height rules at our location (400') and the need to be aware of the rules being finalized between the FAA and the Academy of Model Aeronautics as it will apply to our location near an active airport. Leo had a closing comment about, hopefully, a lot of club members will turn out for the Scale Fly-In on 8/22–23.

Meeting adjourned at 7:30 p.m.

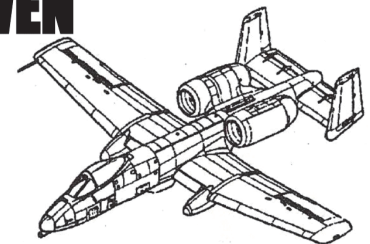
