




The picture above shows the proper method of securing the gate. The Hannigans are using this gate to access their property as well. They have the combination to let themselves in. Also, be aware that they drive to the north end of their property by passing right behind the far side of our runway. Be extra cautious when you're flying and this happens. Last one out lock up if they are not there.

#### **News from AMA and FAA**

The club has received an airspace authorization waiver to allow flights above 400'. Our club field is located in class G airspace and as such is normally restricted to 400' AGL for all flights. The document below lists an extension to either 700 or 1200 based on airspace. Our flying field is in Class G that is overlaid with a Class E and we are on the shaded side of the Class E (Magenta colored). The shaded side is also known as transition airspace so the Class E space inside the shading starts at 700' AGL. Our field then would have a maximum altitude of 700' AGL unless we get a specific 'event waiver.'

Last point, we have written to our AMA District person Daren Hudson, about the requirement for a letter from Northampton Airport. We will require one to exceed 400' AGL operations according to Section 2.H. Daren has forwarded our info to Tyler and the AMA Gov. Affairs Team. So until then, stay below the 400' maximum.

OPERATIONS AUTHORIZED

Authorizes the establishment of Fixed Sites for the Academy of Model Aeronautics (AMA) for the purposes of conducting limited recreational operations of unmanned aircraft pursuant to 49 USC 44809 and consistent with the current version of AC-91-57.

Class of Airspace: Class G

Location: Nationwide, establishing FAA-authorized AMA fixed sites. See Attachment 1. This Authorization is issued under the authority of 49 USC 44809(a) and (c).

- This certificate shall be presented for inspection upon the request of any authorized representative of the Federal Aviation Administration, or of any State or municipal official charged with the duty of enforcing local laws or regulations.
- The holder of this certificate shall be responsible for the strict observance of the terms and provisions contained herein.
- This certificate is nontransferable.

Note-This certificate constitutes an authorization pursuant to those Federal statutes, rules, or regulations specifically referred to above. It does not constitute a waiver or authorization with respect to any State law or local ordinance.

#### SPECIAL PROVISIONS

#### 1. CONTACT INFORMATION:

- a. Lucas Rodden is the person responsible for the implementation and administration of this Authorization on behalf of AMA. The overall safety of each unmanned aircraft system (UAS) operation under this Certificate of Authorization remains with the individual operator of the UAS in accordance with 49 USC 44809.
- The aviation event director is responsible for the overall compliance with the AMA's safety guidelines for any aviation events i.e. airshows, air races, etc.

#### 2. FLIGHT OPERATIONS:

- a. Unmanned aircraft operations are permitted up to the maximum altitude of Class G airspace based on FAA aeronautical charts, 700ft or up to 1200ft AGL as applicable. See Attachment 1 for specific altitudes authorized at specific sites. "Ground level" begins at the Earth's surface and does not include manmade structures, trees, or any obstacle. The applicable 700ft or 1200ft AGL altitudes are an absolute value and shall not be added to the height of any structures or obstacles.
- b. This Certificate of Authorization, including the Special Provisions, is limited in effect to the hours between civil sunrise and civil sunset local time. Night-time operations are authorized only up to 400ft AGL and in accordance with AMA guidelines.
- c. The responsible person must ensure all AMA members and AMA club officers are familiar with and comply with the responsibilities and procedures in this authorization.
- d. The responsible person must ensure all AMA rules and applicable safety quidelines are used by all participants and enforced by AMA officials.
- e. AMA, in accordance with its established safety guidelines, must request a NOTAM covering operations at fixed sites prior to any AMA-aviation event permitted at fixed sites by this Authorization. Such events are not authorized until FAA issues an appropriate NOTAM in response to AMA's request.
- Aviation events operating under this Authorization must have 3 miles of visibility and a ceiling of 3000ft AGL or greater.
- g. All operations must be within VLOS of the fixed site reference point (See Attachment 1) and conform to all applicable federal, state, and local governmental laws and regulations.
- For operations at fixed sites within 2nm of an airport in Class G airspace, the AMA must have a letter of agreement with the airport owner/operator

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regarding the conduct of AMA operations.

- The responsible person must ensure AMA members are briefed for awareness of possible increased aviation activity in the area before conducting operations at fixed sites within 2nm of charted manned aeronautical activities.
- The responsible person must ensure AMA members are briefed on any operational limitations based on fixed site field size, location, and proximity to congested areas.
- If a conflict exists between this Authorization and any other guidance governing recreational operations, the more restrictive provisions will apply.
- Any modifications, additions, or deletions to Attachment 1 must be submitted as an amendment through DroneZone. Please reference this authorization number when submitting any amendment.
