We are asking that everyone purchase a share a month to help fund the land purchase. Please either come to the meetings or mail in your contributions.


The board of directors meeting will be held in February at Pat Malone's house. Bill Ewers to send an invite to all executives and directors.

We only have two short years (01/01/2026) to raise the funds needed to purchase this property. These certificates are valued at \$100 per share. They will mature in 60 months to be able to be redeemed at face value on a funds available basis. Please purchase as many as you can reasonably afford. You can acquire these certificates one of two ways.
