No Quorum Present – 8 Members including 4 Executive Members present: Mike Shaw, Gus Coelho, Pat Malone, Bill Ewers, Mark Wasielewski, Dan Kapinos, Dave Whiteley and Dennis Walker

Reading of the minutes from the previous month was waived. Club finances for the month of August were reported and approved.

The club was offered rental land to fly off in Granby off 202. It looked promising initially, but club officers went to look at it and found that there were trees, a school with baseball field and some other area that was utilized by the school. The land is not large enough and has too much pedestrian traffic to be a good field for us.

All of the executives were nominated for re-election. Mark Wasielewski was nominated to retain his position on the board of directors.

We are working on fundraising to support the land purchase:

- 1. Go Fund Me Now live! We ask everyone to alert their family and friends and ask them to donate! Mike sent out an email asking everyone to do this. Please feel free to copy and paste the email that he sent in your emails to your friends and family.
- 2. Selling Land Shares We are now selling land shares. Please consider purchasing land shares to support this club initiative. Each share is a \$100 commitment and has a 5-year maturity period.

When the club savings and selling of the land across the street are accounted for, we are well over halfway to our goal. We are asking that everyone purchase a share each month to help fund the land purchase. Please either come to the meetings or mail in your contributions.


<u>SHARING:</u> This GFM program will only be successful by sharing the link below with <u>everyone</u> you know and some that you don't.

So, I continue to search for ideas on how to hang my planes in my basement 'hanger.' I came across this unique idea and thought I'd give it a try..

Many viewers ask us how we hang our planes. In this Fast Tip, Chad and Josh share some cheap and easy tricks you can do to safely store your RC airplane.



Wire coat hangers! These things work great, and they are typically cheap (or free) in most cases.





To cut the coat hanger, use the 'cutter' part on your pliers!

Running a wire loop around the wing spar is another great way to create a hanger mount.





Running the wire through solid parts of your RC plane is the best practice to ensure your plane doesn't fall or wear through after a long time hanging.





Don't use rubber bands! After a few weeks, the rubber will dry rot and your plane will be on the floor.
